



eReads FAQs

Q: What are *READ 180* eReads?

A: eReads are a Web-based component of *READ 180* Next Generation that provide extensions of the *READ 180* Next Generation Software topics. Each eRead article also has a related *Scholastic Reading Counts! (SRC!)* quiz.

Because eReads are Web-based, they may be accessed from any computer with an Internet connection (for example, in a classroom, library, or home). eReads also include interactive elements such as article ratings, slide shows, and opinion polls.

Q: How does my child get access to eReads?

A: In order for your child to access eReads, your child's teacher must have turned eReads on for him or her.

If your child is having trouble accessing eReads, please contact his or her teacher.

Q: Where does my child get his or her username and password?

A: Your child's teacher should give your child a *READ 180* username and password. The eReads username and password are the same.

If your child does not have a username or password for eReads, please contact his or her teacher.

Q: How does my child get to the eReads page?

A: Students may access eReads from any computer with an Internet connection by going to www.read180.com/ereads.

On your child's first log-in, he or she will have to:

1. Enter the **zip code** of his or her school district and click **OK**
2. Select the **school district name** from the pull down menu and click **GO**
3. Type in his or her ***READ 180* username and password**
4. Click **Go On**

On subsequent log-ins, your child will need to:

1. Type in his or her ***READ 180* username and password**
2. Click **Go On**
